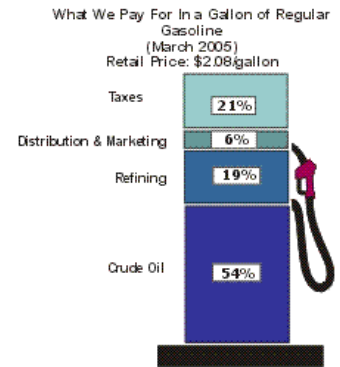

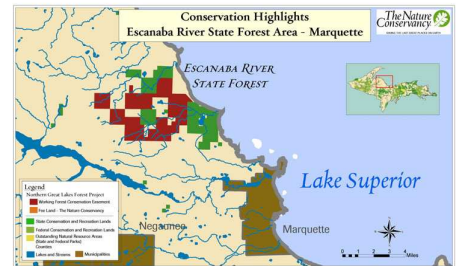

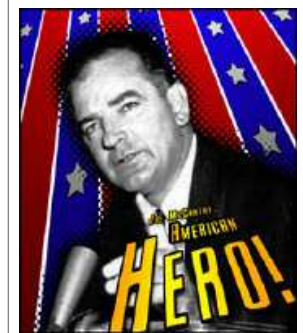

U.N. Wants \$845 Billion From U.S. By Cliff Kincaid September 2, 2005

U.S. Ambassador to the U.N. John Bolton is quoted in Thursday's Washington Post as saying that while the U.S. supports more development assistance to those countries that demonstrate an ability to use aid effectively, "the U.S. does not accept global aid targets or global taxes." This marks a breakthrough. The paper's U.N. correspondent, Colum Lynch, has finally noted that the issue of "global taxes" has been on the table at the U.N. He still hasn't disclosed that the "international community" wants to soak the U.S. for an additional \$845 billion.

The comments were included in the final paragraph of Lynch's story about how Bolton is objecting to various provisions of the "draft outcome document" being prepared for world leaders at the U.N.'s World Summit next month. The comments followed charges by Jeffrey Sachs, a top adviser to U.N. Secretary-General Kofi Annan, that Bolton is trying to "gut" the document.

But Bolton's comments should be big news. America is a nation born in a tax revolt when King George tried to tax us. Do Americans support global taxes for the U.N.? We anxiously await the results of major media opinion polls on this question.

Until Lynch quoted Bolton's comments on the matter, our Big Media had carefully concealed this fact from the American people. The key global tax proposal is for a "a solidarity contribution on plane tickets to finance development projects." This is U.N. doublespeak for an international tax on airline travel. The French, who are pushing the idea, want a tax of about \$6 per passenger worldwide, with a \$25 surcharge for business class, generating

about \$12 billion a year. But this is only the proverbial tip of the iceberg. A global tax on energy could generate tens of billions of dollars a year while an international tax on currency transactions could generate trillions.

The world body is pushing global taxes, in the name of fulfilling the U.N.'s "Millennium Development Goals" for increased foreign-aid spending, because it knows that the U.S. would never voluntarily turn over another \$845 billion. This is the amount of money that Sachs says the U.S. is obligated to spend, over and above what the U.S. is already providing. Sachs says the U.S. is "short" by \$65 billion a year. Over a 13 year period, from 2002, when the U.N.'s Financing for Development Conference was held, to the target year of 2015, that adds up to \$845 billion.

Now that Bolton has objected to this looting of the American government and taxpayer, the U.N. and its collaborators are fighting back. Taking the media assault to a new level, the Los Angeles Times accused Bolton of seeking changes in the U.N. document that would result in millions of deaths. NGOs are spewing out anti-Bolton press releases saying that the U.S. is turning its back on victims of AIDS and poverty. One group, which calls itself Results, claims that Bolton's "trashing" of the summit document will result in lowering the bar "for humanity's progress." The Results group organized a conference call for journalists on Wednesday with Annan adviser Sachs, who was scheduled to discuss the "implications of U.S. proposed revisions" in the summit document "for poverty reduction around the world."

Meanwhile, the U.N. has announced that Annan himself has "reiterated his full support" for including the Millennium Development Goals in the summit document and says that any effort to remove the targets "would hurt billions of people."

So the number of Bolton's potential victims has now risen into the billions!

It should be apparent that we are witnessing a carefully orchestrated campaign trashing Bolton and his staff, who are working overtime to correct major flaws in a U.N. document that is designed to expand the authority and power of the U.N. at the literal expense of the U.S. Our media have openly taken sides against the U.S. position.

The campaign is facilitated by the fact that the U.N. Correspondents Association (UNCA), the group of journalists covering the U.N. on a daily basis, enjoys a very cozy relationship with the world body. The relationship is so close that one journalist, The Nation's U.N. correspondent, has taken money from the world body. Other reporters are paid by the U.N. to appear on the U.N. "World Chronicle" television program. UNCA's conferences are subsidized by pro-U.N. organizations funded by billionaire George Soros and Ted Turner, which helps explain why our major media refuse to examine the big money behind the pro-U.N. lobby.

The Results group, for example, listed the Soros-funded Open Society Institute as its largest donor in 2003, having contributed at least \$200,000 to the organization. In his book, *The End of Poverty*, Sachs himself praises Soros as a

"world-class philanthropist and financier" and one of the "miracle workers in promoting global justice who have generously helped me in my own activities..."

For his part, Sachs advocates a "global tax on carbon-emitting fossil fuels..." that "would finance a greatly enhanced supply of global public goods." A book prepared by the U.N., *New Sources of Development Finance*, endorses such a proposal.

The headline in the Post should say, "U.N. Wants to Raise Global Taxes on Gasoline." But if a reporter wrote a story to go with that headline, that might generate negative feelings toward the U.N. at a time of rising gas prices in the U.S. Some people might even get the impression that the U.N. wants to play the role of a new King George.

U. S. WANTS "DISARMAMENT" PURGED FROM U. N. BLUEPRINT

UNITED NATIONS, Sept 1 (Reuters) - The United States on Thursday proposed deleting all references to disarmament from a draft U.N. reform plan to be adopted at a summit of world leaders in New York later this month.

U.S. Ambassador John Bolton said the extensive revisions sought by Washington in the section of the draft plan focusing on proliferation and disarmament would "significantly strengthen and focus it with respect to responding effectively to current and emerging threats."

"Our changes identify as well the proposals in the current draft that run contrary to U.S. policies and, as such, will not receive U.S. endorsement," he wrote in a letter to his 190 U.N. colleagues.

Bolton's suggestions target a "core group" of about 30 nations scrambling on behalf of all 191 U.N. member-nations to complete the reform blueprint in time for its adoption at the close of the Sept. 14-16 world summit in New York.

More than 170 world leaders are expected to attend the summit including U.S. President George W. Bush.

Washington has come under

fire from other U.N. members and private interest groups for pursuing hundreds of proposed changes in the document in negotiations that began just weeks before the summit opening.

But U.S. officials say they are simply pursuing their right to do their best to ensure the document reflects U.S. interests. Bolton said on Wednesday the United States had been pressing its case for months, but with only limited success.

Bolton has sent out a series of letters this week detailing U.S. suggestions for the draft sections on development, U.N. management reform, terrorism, human rights and peacebuilding.

"TRUE THREAT" IS PROLIFERATION

In his latest letter, dealing with disarmament and nonproliferation, he proposed purging the word "disarmament" because the draft that negotiators now have before them "emphasizes disarmament, when the true threat to international security stems from proliferation."

He also proposed dropping references to a moratorium on nuclear testing, which the U.S. administration questions; an

international treaty banning land mines, which Washington has not signed, and verifiable nuclear weapons-free zones -- an idea that Arab states promote for the Middle East in hopes of embarrassing Israel over its presumed nuclear weapons.

Bolton also suggested deleting a plea for additional controls on the illegal trade in small arms, which African nations say fuels the continent's many civil wars.

While the United States remains committed to "practical, effective measures" against small arms trafficking where urgently needed, it also backs "the legal trade, manufacture and ownership of arms" and the summit should instead focus on weapons of mass destruction and the possibility they may fall into the hands of terrorists, he said.

Bolton also proposed deleting a mention of "the peaceful use of nuclear energy," a provision of the nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty that Washington says Iran is hiding behind to produce nuclear arms, an allegation Tehran denies.

PHILADELPHIA - Just days before "Southern Decadence", an annual homosexual celebration attracting tens of thousands of people to the French Quarters section of New Orleans, an act of God destroys the city.

HOODWINKING THE SHEEPLE

Sustainable Development (SD) is most often defined as "Development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their needs." Sounds good on the surface, but SD is really a horrid plot being carried out by Commie Collectivists who want the great unwashed to work their keister off, sacrificing individualism to the "act locally, think globally" collectivism of the "group".



Under "Collectivism" there are no unalienable Rights and no system of government based on "of, for, and by the people". People don't own the government; government owns the people and takes total control of everything they have, including children.

Under "Collectivism", you'll do what's expected without question like dutiful Sheeple or hit the high-road to internment complexes, where global researchers can use you like human guinea pigs to test one of their "cutting edge" bio-med breakthroughs.

In the new pecking order, elitists running the show will have everything and the Sheeple will have only as much as elitists allow them to have, which will only be enough to sustain a miserable lifestyle... a lifestyle they, and not you, determine is suitable because you, like all else, are just a commodity based on your value to the collective group.

And, while we may think our local county or village government has final say over the direction the community takes, our elected officials can and will bend to the will of a stakeholder council because, after all,

public meetings have been held and "all" have had their say.

The problem is that local citizens are only one stakeholder group among many, and other stakeholder groups, often in cahoots with one another, come from all over. If truth were known, few locals would be in favor of the rigged stakeholder consensus building process, which has the effect of eliminating ballot referendums or drastically minimizing the local voice.

A trained facilitator, frequently paid big bucks for a few hours work, runs a typical stakeholder meeting. It's not his job to make sure all views are heard. Instead, his job is to guide the group to arrive at a pre-conceived consensus of opinion to resolve a problem trumpeted as threatening to the locals, i.e. preserving wilderness by severely minimizing public land access or stopping housing developments and new industry through public land purchases to preserve thousands upon thousands of acres of forestland. A facilitator's job is to protect the interest of those he represents, not solve a contrived "problem" in the interest of John Q. Public.

Once a problem, real or imagined, is identified, every non-government, non-profit, and local government has a treasure trove of pre-ordained SD solutions at hand, provided by the International Council for Local Environmental Initiatives (ICLEI).

Launched in 1990 at the World Congress of Local Governments for a Sustainable Future, ICLEI is based in Toronto, Canada. Its stated mission is to "assist local governments in the implementation of Sustainable Development". In fact, every county in America now has Sustainable Development directives guided by federal agencies, NGOs, and/or ICLEI. And that, folks, is how the UN gets its nasty nose into the business of local government and land use planning without us being any the wiser.

The list of money sources for implementing SD is extensive, but essentially American taxes fund the federal agencies involved. Additionally, over two thousand NGOs, accredited by the UN for the purpose of implementing SD nationally, are given massive tax advantages by the IRS. After government and non-profit funding schemes, another financial windfall comes through tax-exempt family foundations; the Rockefeller Foundation, Pew Charitable Trusts, Turner Foundation, Charles Stewart Mott Foundation, to name a very few.

Sustainable Development is a plan for global control, using land and other resource restrictions, socially engineering sheeple through education (the call for educating hunters re QDM is an example), and other programs to accomplish a pre-determined end.

The land use element calls for executing two action plans designed to eliminate private property: the Wildlands Project and Smart Growth. Under these plans, all human action is subject to control, a control we're just beginning to feel. It's only going to get worse, much worse, unless we start weeding out the buzzards occupying seats at every level of government.

The Wildlands Project is a horrid plan to eliminate the human footprint on a minimum of 50% of the American landscape, to heavily control human activity on the rest, and to reduce human populations by 50%. The Wildlands Project people are trying to collectivize all natural resources and centralize all use decisions under government direction, and they're often doing it through public-private partnerships in league with government insiders. They're doing this in the UIP by expanding habitat "protection" provisions of the manipulated Endangered Species Act, various "conservation easements", and direct land acquisitions.

President Bush Nominates Pro-Life Woman to Key Population Post

Washington, DC (LifeNews.com) -- President Bush has named a pro-life woman to a key population post within the State Department. The president appointed Ellen Sauerbrey, a former Maryland state lawmaker and gubernatorial candidate, to become assistant secretary of state for population. Sauerbrey, whose nomination must be approved by the Senate, has been a strong pro-life advocate as the U.S. representative to the U.N. Commission on the Status of Women. She has been instrumental in ensuring important United Nations documents do not promote abortion. In her new position, Sauerbrey

would oversee more than \$700 million worth of programs for refugee protection, resettlement and humanitarian assistance, according to an Associated Press report. This year, Sauerbrey lobbied other nations to include language in a document reaffirming a declaration on women and population developed at the [1995 Cairo population conference](#) to ensure that it did not back abortion. The U.S. eventually agreed to drop the request for the language when other nations agreed that they would not use the document to promote overturning laws against abortion in dozens of countries. Sauerbrey told reporters

in March that nations agreed abortion decisions should be made at the national and not the international level. "I think one of the things that has been very clearly established that should give a lot of comfort to concerned Americans is that virtually every country said we interpret it the same as you -- we interpret that these are issues of national sovereignty," Sauerbrey said. Darla St. Martin, associate executive director of National Right to Life, told LifeNews.com that "Ellen Sauerbrey had worked very hard carrying out the president's pro-life policies."

In government it seems only the incompetent get promoted and in the private sector only the most competent are promoted while the incompetent complain about how much more money the competent make than them.

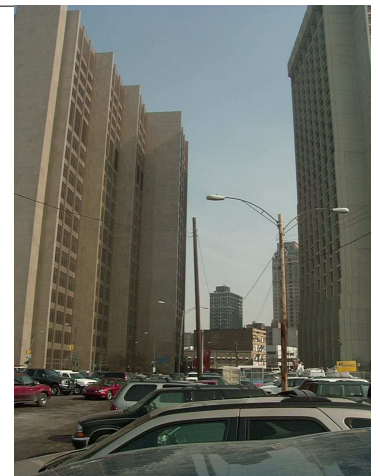
In our schools, the children are pushed along with expectations that are nearly non-existent. In some districts they want to get away from the grading system and offer a more friendly grading standard with no red ink.

The Fallacy of Aztlan by Hunainoa

There is much consternation and confusion over those portions of the United States claimed by the "Reconquistas", (re-conquerors) but the "green thing" is never mentioned in the confusion and consternation. And because we no longer teach our own history, the "Reconquistas" will win out.

First, in 1848, under the Treaty of Guadalupe-Hidalgo, <http://www.loc.gov/exhibits/ghtreaty/>, the United States paid Mexico \$15,000,000 to compensate her citizens for damages to private property during the war, which Mexico lost. Mexicans who lived within the post-treaty border (the ceded 55% lands!) who did not wish to abide by the treaty signed by Mexico at the conclusion of this war could return to Mexico. Those who elected to stay were offered citizenship in the United States but they had to disavow allegiance to Mexico.

Second, in 1853, the United States paid Mexico \$10,000,000 for the lands commonly referred to as "The Gadsden Purchase," <http://www.progress.org/gads.htm>. As any American schoolchild should know, the Gadsden Purchase was a real estate deal (just like the Louisiana Purchase and the Alaska Purchase) regarding a disputed

strip of land across the bottom of Arizona and New Mexico where the border now lies. This purchase became necessary because there was an oversight in the Treaty of Guadalupe-Hidalgo regarding access to El Paso, Texas, by citizens in the ceded lands to those areas west of that city. The United States paid \$10,000,000 for this 29,000-acre strip of land rather than get into another war and made the payment to the other country involved in the oversight: Mexico.

Money changed hands here, folks -- a fact that is conveniently forgotten by the "Reconquistas". For those who can't understand what I just wrote, I repeat: in 1848, the United States paid then-President of Mexico Santa Ana \$15,000,000 for damaged Mexican private property as part of the treaty that also ceded to the US 55% of Mexican territories; in 1853, the United States paid then-President of Mexico Santa Ana \$10,000,000 in exchange for the lands commonly referred to as the Gadsden Purchase. This is the same Santa Ana of Alamo and Battle of San Jacinto infamy. If the \$10,000,000 did not make its way into the coffers of

Mexico for the benefit of the people of Mexico or if the government of Mexico did not pay the \$15,000,000 to citizens of Mexico who sustained damage to their property during the fifty-year war between Mexico and the United States, that is not a problem that the United States needs to concern herself with. That is Mexico's business and her problem, if one exists. The United States owns these lands the "Reconquistas" claim.

Considering that no move has been made to honor the terms of previous loans to Mexico, I think it would be safe to assume that the "Reconquistas" have no intention of paying that money back or seeing that Mexico does so. The sole argument of the "Reconquistas" is they want back land that was lost in a fifty-year war and/or purchased outright by the winner of the war, the United States.

If Mexico wants to pay back all loans by the United States to Mexico, with interest from the date each loan was made to the date each is repaid, plus the aforesaid \$25,000,000, with interest from the dates of each payment to the present, and pay the current owners of private property in the lands the "Reconquistas" claim for

themselves, the value of their property before vandalizing and destruction by the influx of illegals, with interest and cost of all improvements since purchase, and with interest on the value of the improvements from the date of each such improvement, then maybe we have something to talk about. Until then, the purported "Reconquistas" are bound by the terms of the Treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo and the Gadsden Purchase to either put up or shut up; stay as citizens of the United States or return to Mexico! In either case, if the "Reconquistas" don't like what either country did, they have the right and obligation to leave the United States instead of undermining our government, destroying private property and assaulting American citizens, as well as inciting others to do all these things.

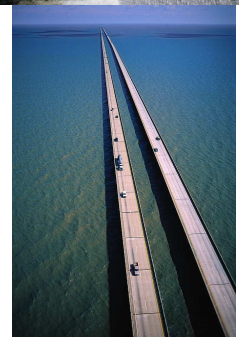
WHERE ARE THE ENVIRONMENTALIST NOW?

West Virginia Senator Robert C. Byrd (D), has put into law the requirement that schools and federal employees read and study the Constitution of the United States in honor of the signing held on September 17, 1787. Section. 7.

Clause 2: Every Bill which shall have passed the House of Representatives and the Senate, shall, before it become a Law, be presented to the President of the United States; If he approve he shall sign it, but if not he shall return it, with his Objections to that House in which it shall have originated, who **shall** enter the Objections at large on their Journal, and **proceed to reconsider it**. If after such Reconsideration two thirds of that House shall agree to pass the Bill, it shall be sent, together with the Objections, to the other House, by which it **shall likewise be reconsidered**, and if approved by two thirds of that House, it shall become a Law. **But in all**

such Cases the Votes of both Houses shall be determined by yeas and Nays, and the Names of the Persons voting for and against the Bill shall be entered on the Journal of each House respectively. If any Bill shall not be returned by the President within ten Days (Sundays excepted) after it shall have been presented to him, the Same shall be a Law, in like Manner as if he had signed it, unless the Congress by their Adjournment prevent its Return, in which Case it shall not be a Law.

Simply stated, the bill that would have prohibited partial birth abortion and vetoed by Bill Clinton HAD to be reconsidered in Congress.



This is only one example of the failure of Congress to abide by the Constitution. No bills, like the Midwest flood assistance bill, may have riders to pay cash awards to their constituents. The government, not the Federal Reserve Bank, is the only authority allowed to regulate the value of money. By law we read the Constitution?
