How can we determine whether something is a good thing or not a good thing? The 1990s sold the farm to the UN and to the environmentalists. A consolidation between the Bark River and Perronville parishes was underway and the very capable Father Sample was in charge. The new community church is now called St. Elizabeth Anne Seton Parish. The aging buildings determined which one would be best to invest in and a declining membership required a responsive joint venture.

The first time that I had seen Father Sample in Bark River, I was actually stunned and amazed at his aura of reverence and devotion. I even thought that he may one day be our Pope.

Father Sample was assigned to St. Christopher's in Marquette, so it was always a pleasure when our road led us to Marquette for mass. Our most recent mass at St. Christopher's was done without the benefit of a choir. Father Sample, who was blessed with a good singing voice, conducted a large portion of the mass acappella and led the congregation in song. That was the first mass in ages when we were treated to a respectful silence during communion and could spend that too infrequent time contemplating the Eucharist. Father Sample had recognized the devotion and commented about the treasure of our moments spent in contemplative silence.

Since 2000, the membership in the Diocese of Marquette had fallen 19%: just over 27.000 people attended mass during the last census. This is unacceptable, especially at this time when Pantheism and atheism is dominating the very young and very weak souls. A firm religious structure built on God's foundation is needed in our lives.

Father Sample will be accepting the leadership role at a time when we are in need of spiritual direction the most. The pews are nearly void of children and even young adults, the Blessed Sacraments have become more of a go-through-themotions type of requirement and the Tabernacle is placed on the side or even out of view in many Catholic churches. Other trials that have befallen the Church is the liberalization of the Word of God through inclusive language and the sex scandals that had coincided with the liberalization. In my time, Bishop Noa would attend all the Confirmations throughout the Diocese; this was at a time when the roads were far more horrendous. There was no such thing as a straight line among road engineers.

Father Sample will have his work cut-out for him as our new Bishop. A student of Cannon Law, he will be an asset in the conversion of souls and will be beneficial to those who have left the Catholic Faith. ## Jane Fonda: U.S. Troops Are 'Killing Machines'

"Hanoi Jane" Fonda is claiming that ever since Vietnam, U.S. troops have been trained to commit atrocities against innocent civilians as a matter of military policy.

"Starting with the Vietnam War we began training soldiers differently," the anti-American actress says in an email to the Washington Post.

Fonda claims she learned of the policy switch in "secret meetings" she had with military psychologists "who were really worried about what was happening to our combat personnel." One doctor, she insists, told her U.S. troops had been deliberately trained to be "killing machines."

"This began," Fonda maintained, "because the military discovered that in World War II and Korea, [U.S.] soldiers weren't killing enough."

"So they changed training procedures" to teach troops how to commit atrocities.

Still, the anti-war gadfly cautions, it's important not to blame the soldiers themselves for carrying out war crimes.

Recalling the "Winter Soldier" hearings that she and John Kerry staged in 1971, Fonda

lamented: "When you put young people into an atrocity-producing situation where enemy and civilian are commingled, where the 'other side' is dehumanized, we cannot be surprised."

Anti-war vets now returning from Iraq, Fonda cautioned, should be listened to instead of being dismissed as "unpatriotic."

"We have not learned the lessons of Vietnam," she declared.
