# Granholm opens mansion, administration to LGBTs By Jan Stevenson

LANSING - Governor Jennifer Granholm and her staff hosted an afternoon tea gathering of about 100 LGBT leaders and activists at the Governor's mansion on April 19. This was the first time a sitting Michigan governor invited a group of LGBT people to the mansion, and many in attendance felt the historical significance of the event.

"From our community standpoint it was a great thing for all of us to be together under the governor's roof. It was an exciting and energizing thing," said Jeffrey Montgomery, executive director of the Detroit-based Triangle Foundation. "We were invited into the house of a friend and I think that is very, very important."

Nearly 20 of the governor's staff joined her on the stage in the mansion's large, dramatic living room. Granholm introduced each one, and made a point of acknowledging that four of her full time staff are gay men, including her chief of staff John Burchett, and Jim Stokes, the director of her Detroit office.

"You know you have a friend in the Governor," said Granholm. "I campaigned on my vision of One Michigan, and the LGBT community is part of that. I want to talk about some important issues, for example I think we all want to amend the Elliott Larsen Civil Rights Act to include sexual orientation, but that would be very difficult with the current legislature."

Kenn Bing asked the governor to talk about her position on second parent adoption rights for same-sex couples. He and his partner are raising a little girl, but he explained that only his partner has parental rights because they were unable to adopt her together.

"It is my position that whatever is in the best interests of the child is what should be our priority," said Granholm. Just then, Bing's three-year-old daughter, Destiny, ran up to him and, while clinging to his leg, smiled up at the governor. "It is clear where this little one's bond is. It is always important to remember that this is about the children."

Johnny Jenkins, co-founder of the Black Pride Society, said that although he appreciated the historic significance of the event, he sees it as only a first step on a long road.

"I thought it was necessary on her part to mend some fences with us," said Jenkins, who said he still feels some skepticism because of the governor's hesitance to come out publicly in

2004 against Prop. 2, the antimarriage constitutional amendment. "I think inviting the statewide leaders of our community into her home was great symbolism, but we come from a community that is ready for action and commitment from our allies. We don't need lukewarm allies political or economic. I think she still has some work to do with us. I look forward to the next invite."

"I believe it was the first time I heard her say that the LGBT community is part of her One Michigan approach," said Leslie Thompson, executive director of Affirmations Lesbian and Gay Community Center in Ferndale. "I was also impressed that she appointed so many LGBT people on her staff."

Thompson also considered the gathering a beginning, and hopes that the governor will become a more active leader for LGBT rights. "I guess I am still looking for a more vocal stance on our issues outside of the comfort zone of the LGBT community. I would have liked to have seen her as pas-

sionate about Proposal 2 as she was about the Casino issue in Detroit," said Thompson, who mentioned that the governor will be attending the Affirmations Big Bash this weekend.

Although this was not a political event (the governor may not campaign from the official residence), it was hard to miss that Granholm is facing a tough challenge from Republican Dick DeVos this election year.

"I think everyone leaving that event realized that this upcoming election

is a very significant one for our community," said Montgomery, who strongly supports Granholm for reelection. "Everyone is going to have to be very committed

to maintain her in office." "I think it was a great thing to do," said Barbara Murray, executive director of AIDS Partnership Michigan in Detroit. "It's pretty clear from the polls right now that she's in for a tough race. When you are in that kind of situation it makes sense to reach out to your natural constitu-

Murray said that she was surprised that Granholm had not mentioned HIV/AIDS in her remarks. "As an AIDS service provider, I wish she had said something about AIDS. In the last six months we have seen two AIDS agencies go under, and each time that happens our client load goes up. I look to the governor for support on HIV & AIDS."

Granholm will be the Grand Marshall at AIDS Walk Michigan this fall, said Murray.

ate within the parameters set by our Constitution.


We must restore TRUST to our market places, our shopping centers, our churches, our streets, and all other



## Politics Bites—Targeting by the Feds for Show

WASHINGTON — Immigration U.S. Immigration and Customs agents arrested seven executives and hundreds of employees of a manufacturer of crates and pallets Wednesday as part of a crackdown on employers of illegal workers.

Authorities raided offices and plants of IFCO Systems in at least nine states, the culmination of a yearlong criminal investigation, law enforcement officials said.

**Enforcement** agents arrested seven current and former IFCO Systems managers on charges they conspired to transport, harbor and encourage illegal workers to reside in the United States for commercial advantage and private financial gain, said Glenn T. Suddaby, the chief federal prosecutor in Albany, N.Y., where some arrests were made.

ICE spokeswoman Jamie Zuieback confirmed an unspecified number of raids and arrests, but declined to provide additional details because the investigation was continuing. One official, speaking on condition of anonymity because numbers were still being tallied, said the arrests were in the hundreds.

#### Wind-fall Profit Tax & Other Excellent Penalties

Senator Carl Levin (D—Michigan) has proposed imposing a wind-fall profit tax on oil companies. No one yet mentioned that the grotesque profits gleaned by big oil are taxed and the federal government alone received half of their profits. Now we ask you, who would put the profits to better use, big oil or the government?

Chances are, if you own a diverse stock portfolio, 401K or other type of investment account, you own some shares of big oil. The fact that people profit is not a reason to penalize them or you.

In the State of Michigan, gas stations are required to purchase gas with a 9.9% pre-paid sales tax.

When the suppliers of gas need to calculate the base price per gallon, they subtract the state and federal tax (.19 and .18.4 respectively) to come up with a base price. Once the base price is calculated, they then add back in the federal tax, which is then taxed at the 9.9% sales tax, or 16.8 cents per gallon Michigan sales, due on delivery to the stations.

Because the cost of gas is going up, the pre-paid tax is going from 9.9% to 12.7% on May 1. The pre-paid tax was imposed to prevent gas stations from not paying the required taxes - many were just skipping giving the state their portion.

The gas tax is just like the tobacco tax;

add the price of the product, plus .19 cents state, plus .18.4 federal, plus 0.875 cents environmental fee AND then add a 6% sales tax to the whole kit and caboodle.

The actual cost of a gallon of gas is around \$1.99 before taxes and other charges are imposed. There is also 7.5 cents per gallon transportation fee added to the cost (to Negaunee). The final cost per gallon to the gas station owner is \$2.89 per gallon.

A final tidbit; the State of Michigan makes \$30,000,000 (million) for every ten (10) cent increase in gas prices. On the other side, Congress wants to launch yet another investigation into price gouging allegations, but neglect investigating their own taxing of citizens into oblivion.



#### Mandate

The United Nations Human Settlements Programme, UN-HABITAT, is the United Nations agency for human settlements. It is mandated by the UN General Assembly to promote socially and environmentally sustainable towns and cities with the goal of providing adequate shelter for all. The main documents outlining the mandate of the organization are the <u>Vancouver Declaration on Human Settlements</u>, <u>Habitat Agenda</u>, <u>Istanbul Declaration on Human Settlements</u>, the <u>Declaration on Cities and Other Human Settlements</u> in the New Millennium, and <u>Resolution</u> 56/206

The agency's 2002-2003 budget is US\$300 million and comes from four main sources - 80 per cent in the form of contributions from multilateral and bilateral partners for technical cooperation, 10 percent in earmarked contributions from governments and other partners, including local authorities and foundations, with 5 per cent from the regular UN budget and 5 per cent in the form of voluntary contributions from governments.

Mexicans who lived within the post-treaty border (the ceded 55% lands!) who did not wish to abide by the treaty signed by Mexico at the conclusion of this war could return to Mexico. Those who elected to stay were offered citizenship in the united States but they had to disavow allegiance to Mexico.


