
In case you've been hiding under your bed for the last month or so, you've missed the new trend in the global warming game; it's now simply called Hadcru Ha

Texas showdown: Balancing child welfare, religious freedom

Texas officials are trying hard to keep the focus on child abuse—and away from religion—in the custody battle involving 437 children seized from a polygamist religious sect this month.

If only it were so simple.

Like it or not, this conflict is about far more than the issue of older men having sex with under-age girls in violation of Texas law. It's also about religion—specifically the religious culture of the Fundamentalist Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (FLDS).

Defenders of the church argue that the raid was an overreaction to one telephone call (that might have been a hoax) and was motivated by longstanding animus toward the FLDS community. The state counters that dramatic measures are justified when evidence points to children trapped in a religious culture that promotes child abuse.

The only way to sort out the truth, and determine the fate of the children, will be to put the FLDS way of life on trial.

Polygamists get little public sympathy—despite the positive spin on HBO's "Big Love." But polygamy and under-age marriage are only part of a larger public concern about the psychological and physical harm children might suffer from being raised in what appears to be an insular, authoritarian environment.

Ordinarily, I bristle when someone labels a religious group a "cult"—a term that, in popular parlance, is often used to describe "a religion I don't like." Adherents of faiths considered mainstream today—Catholics and Mormons, among others—were

derided as "cult members" in the 19th century.

FLDS, however, has all of the marks of a more academic definition of cult: isolated from the world, secretive and beholden to a charismatic leader who exercises absolute power and authority.

Under the First Amendment, of course, cults, sects, and a wide range of religious movements, new and old, are protected in the practice of their faith, no matter how unpopular or isolated from society. Although the U.S. Supreme Court has upheld some limits on religious practice (starting with polygamy in 1878), such cases are rare.

But religious freedom ends when child abuse begins. Adults, for example, might have a right to refuse life-saving health care, including blood transfusions, for themselves—but not for their children.

Defining "abuse," however, is itself subject to abuse, sometimes creating a slippery legal slope that gives people license to persecute unpopular religious groups.

In the early 1800s, the presence of children in Shaker communities led some states to pass laws restricting the rights of Shaker parents, including giving the state power to "rescue children" by awarding custody to the parent who was not a Believer.

More recently, in the 1960s, law enforcement sometimes looked the other way when "de-programmers" snatched young people from new religious movements at the instigation of fearful parents.

Today, Texas officials are employing a sweeping definition of "child abuse" by removing 437 children from their FLDS families. Now the state must

justify its actions by arguing that all of the children were harmed or potentially harmed by life in the church culture. As Tom Vick of the Texas Bar Association (who is rounding up lawyers for the children) puts it: "If it's a dangerous situation for one child, it's a dangerous situation for all."

This is a high bar, far more difficult than a limited investigation into specific allegations of under-age marriage. A victory for the state could mean that none of the children can be safely returned to the church. That could well spell the end of the FLDS community, at least above ground.

That's why Texas should proceed with caution from here on. The outcome of this case could create new grounds for intervention when the government decides an unpopular religious group is inherently detrimental to child welfare.


Temporarily removing the children might have been justified in this case—that's what the courts will need to determine. But the ultimate decision about the children's fate should be based on whether there is clear evidence of systematic sexual abuse rather than on general condemnation of the beliefs of FLDS followers or prejudice against their way of life.

Barring such abuse, these children belong with their parents. Being raised in an unconventional religious system might appall or offend outsiders, but it is not by definition abusive. As much as Texas officials might not want to deal with it, this case is not only about child welfare—it's also about religious freedom.

EU wipes England off the map - as Gordon Brown flies the flag of St George over Downing Street Last updated at 16:23pm on 23rd April 2008



The "Atlantic Region" takes in western England, along with Ireland, Wales and parts of Portugal, Spain, France and Scotland.

Meanwhile eastern England is part of the "North Sea Region", which covers areas of Sweden, Denmark, Germany, Belgium, Norway and the Netherlands.

The Tories have issued a St George's Day rallying cry against plans by Brussels to "wipe England off the map" and create a United Europe.

As Gordon Brown hoisted the English national flag over 10 Downing Street to celebrate St George's Day, it was revealed that EU officials had revised a map wiping out the country and the Channel.

The change splits England into three and lumps those parts together with chunks of other countries to create "transnational regions".

It is claimed these zones - which have been allocated their own budgets - are intended to boost trade between EU nations.

But the Tories yesterday accused the Government of trying "to create a European superstate via the back door".

Under the programme, known as INTER-REG, counties along England's south coast form the "Manche Region" along with northern France.

The UK Government is fully behind the project, even though the words "England" and "Britain" are left off official maps of each area and the Manche Region renames the English Channel "The Channel Sea".

Each region, which will be given taxpayers' money to promote trade links, cultural ties, transport policies and tourism, is to be run by a "managing authority" of unelected officials overseen by a director.

None will be based in the UK, with Manche ruled by the French, Atlantic by the Portuguese and North Sea by the Danes.

The regions have legal status and Manche has a budget of £261million between 2007 and 2013, Atlantic £127million and North Sea £219million.

Every project funded by a region must have a publicity campaign which ensures "there is provision for flying the EU flag at least one week every year".

Eric Pickles, the Conservatives' communities spokesman, said: "We already knew that Gordon Brown had

hoisted the white flag of surrender to the European Constitution.

"Now the Labour Government has been caught red-handed conspiring with European bureaucrats to create a European superstate via the back door.

"Gordon Brown literally wants to wipe England off the map."

But a spokesman for the Department for Communities and Local Government insisted: "It has nothing to do with altering names on maps.

"It is about support for business, helping boost employment and turning around deprived areas... helping firms in Kent do business with people in Northern France or promoting joint tourism initiatives between different countries."

The move came as Gordon Brown ordered that all UK Government buildings with two flag poles should fly the cross of St George alongside the union banner.

It follows a review of flag flying practices. Number 10 will in future fly the Scottish and Welsh flags on their patron saints' days.

Northern Ireland does not have an official national flag, and so the same practice will not apply on St Patrick's Day.

"The Prime Minister's view is that of course we should celebrate our Britishness, but celebrating our Britishness does not mean we cannot also celebrate our Englishness, Scottishness, Welshness or Northern Irishness," said the spokesman.

The English flag last flew over Downing Street during the 2006 World Cup.

Michigan Arsonists Plan Fires for '08 By C. J. Williams

On Oct. 18, 1908 the New York Times reported news of a devastating forest fire that swept through miles of Alpena, Presque Isle and Chebovgan Counties in northern Lower Michigan. In its wake hundreds were left homeless and the remains of the less fortunate, many of them women and children, were found charred in their homesteads and along escape routes, including unrecognizable bodies in a refugee train that jumped the tracks in the burning forest. In fact, at that time most of northern Michigan was burning, as were forests near Sault Ste. Marie.

"The whole country is a firetrap," said Bishop Charles Williams of the Protestant Episcopal Diocese of Michigan, who managed to make his way to the area. "The woods are full of dry, fallen timber, left by the old lumbermen; slashings and old mills with seas on ed wood are everywhere... Everything is parched with drought, yet the people carelessly clear the lands with fire."

Over the years government agencies and timbering companies worked hard to better manage forests so similar catastrophes wouldn't happen. Now, almost 100 years after the devastating fires of 1908, we're learning that the Nature Conservancy (TNC) is dictating management policy to government resource agencies so "ecosystems" in Michigan and other states can be restored to pre-European settlement condition through intentionally set fires.

These fires, known as "prescribed burns", often get out of hand and result in what the Conservancy refers to as "slop over" when private property is destroyed, as happened in the Shakey Lakes area of the Escanaba State Forest several years ago.

In 1980, a "prescribed burn" near Mio in the Mack Lake area of Oscoda County got out of control. It's been noted that few documented wildfires have exceeded the fire's spread rate (2 mi/hr) and energy release rate (8,800 Btu/ft/sec) and that the fires' extreme behavior resulted from high winds, low humidity, low fuel moisture and jack pine fuels.

Now billed as a "tragic accident", the Mack Lake fire was intentionally set by the U.S. Forest Service as part of its habitat management strategy for Kirtland's Warblers. Unfortunately, what should have been a 200-acre burn turned into an inferno that consumed almost 24,000 acres, destroyed 40 homes, and killed one Forest Service worker.

On April 27, 2007, Ottawa National Forest Service personnel intentionally set fire to several spots in the Baraga Plains just south of Prickett Dam. This, too, was designed to enhance habitat for the Kirtland's Warbler, which takes to jack pines like babies take to milk. Two days later, after the fires were thought to be under control, a hot spot erupted and before that fire was contained 1,121 acres burned due to high winds, low humidity, and tinder dry fuels due to long-term drought.

Not only does the Forest Service engage in arson to create habitat for birds and butterflies, but so does the MI-DNR, which boasts on one Webpage to be managing its public land in Roscommon and Ogemaw Counties for Kirtland's Warblers, too. Prescribed burns are part of the land management strategy there, as well.

It should be noted that the Sleeper Lake fire last summer, which burned thousands of acres in Michigan's Upper Peninsula, cost thousands of dollars to contain, and endangered people's property and firefighters' lives, rampaged through an area managed by the Nature Conservancy. While blamed on lightning, TNC is noted for setting fire to forests and fields all over America and it well may be that the Sleeper Lake fire

was another intentional burn that got out of control. A "prescribed burn" in that area would certainly account for the MI-DNR's sudden decision to close several state campgrounds in that area just prior to the inferno.

As recently as Jan. 2008, a prescribed fire in Florida burst its bounds and likely contributed to a multi-car pile up on Interstate 4, causing the death of several people. The planned 10-acre burn became a 400-acre wildfire that ignited a peat bog, which burned for days. It's thought that the heavy smoke, combined with fog, blanketed the highway and led to the devastating multi-car accident.

According to the Michigan Prescribed Fire Council's March 2008 meeting minutes, the Conservancy is planning to burn more acreage at the exclusive 27,000 acre Turtle Lake Hunt Club not far from Mio in Montmorency County; the U.S. Forest Service was still working on a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to cooperate with TNC on burns; an MOU between the TNC and the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service already exists: 36 TNC intentional burns are planned, but most aren't on TNC lands; the MI-DNR Parks & Recreation Division has 56 burns planned (about 6,500 acres); and the MI-DNR Wildlife Division has about 200 burns planned, but the lack of trained personnel, especially burn bosses, limits what the DNR actually gets burned, even if the weather is favorable.

Favorable weather or not, one of the first wildfires to rage through northern Lower Michigan this year occurred on April 26 near Grayling in Crawford County, an area where the MI-DNR manages lots of land. The fire burned at least 1,100 acres and jumped Interstate 75, which was closed due to heavy smoke that made visibility impossible. Fortunately, no lives were lost though there was a great deal of property damage. ~Cj

After the collapse there's rebirth, reconstruction and a new cycle of abundance until the whole thing repeats itself over and over again, one century after the next. Read your world history to hear this same story repeated over at least fifty empires that once existed on Earth. The American empire will be no different: It will drown in its own greed and corruption, collapsing into a state of moral and financial bankruptcy, and then will likely be reborn as a series of smaller nation-states like the Washington / Oregon / Idaho / Northern California region that has very different values and interests than, say, the Texas region.

During all this, there will be lots of social unrest, poverty, personal bankruptcy, police state arrests and perhaps even the widespread use of detection camps to indefinitely hold troublemakers who dare to protest or speak out against government corruption. This is what's coming for America, and the interesting part is that almost nobody in America seems to be able to anticipate this. Yet the writing is on the wall, and it's as obvious as the dot-com crash was before 2000.

I publicly predicted the dot-com crash starting in 1998, and urged everyone to get out of the market through 1999, 2000 and right up until the bursting of the dot-com bubble in early 2001. All this time, nobody listened. Virtually everyone was caught up in the insane illusion that we would all get rich by selling each other pieces of paper with increasingly large numbers written on them (those are the stock prices, you see). Almost everybody was swept up by Groupthink, believing that the laws of

economics had changed forever. CNBC became the cheerleader of unbridled greed, and brainwashed idiots at the American Enterprise Institute were publishing books predicting a Dow of 36,000 that would create infinite wealth requiring no effort or productive work.

Meanwhile, I was urging everyone to sell their stocks, which of course made me look utterly insane given that everybody else in the world was telling people to keep buying -- including all the stock brokers and investment fund managers, who it turns out know almost nothing useful about finances or investments and are just as easily swept up by Groupthink as anything else. When the bubble finally burst, I was completely out of the market and lost nothing. But many people I knew lost big portions of their life savings.

Now, I told you that story to tell you this: What's coming in America's future is going to be far, far worse than the dot-com fiasco. Imagine the financial market breaking down, the U.S. government defaulting on its debt, the dollar going through massive 3hyperinflation, wiping out the value of the life savings of virtually all Americans. Think it can't happen here? That's what the Groupthink thinks. But it will happen here, and the massive corruption in our government is making sure of it. Whatever dollars you have in the bank will, in a few years, become virtually worthless. Hyperinflation is inevitable. Study the history of Germany following World War I to gain additional insight on this topic.

Sacrificing the future for today's profit

When the corporations run a nation, that nation has no real future, because corporations only think in terms of the next quarter, not the next generation. Corporations will naturally do whatever they can to maximize their profits right now, including poisoning the children with vaccines, poisoning the population with toxic food products,

sacrificing the financial future of the nation for short-term gain, destroying the environment, ignoring the health care needs of the People, inciting war so they can sell more profitable weapons to war-torn countries around the world, and so on. Essentially, corporations will sell out the future for higher profits today, and that's exactly what they've done in America.

America has no real future. Not a good one, anyway. I give the nation anywhere from 5 to 25 years before it will self destruct under a mountain of debt, disease and corruption. You can thank the corporations and corrupt ⁴politicians for that. They've thrown away the dream of a nation that was once great and could actually be great again, if not for the greed.

This is all several years away, of course. And until then, most people are going to continue the pursuit of even more debt and disease, oblivious to the future that awaits them. A great book to read on how that future might play out is *The Long Emergency* by James Howard Kunstler. Or *The Party's Over: Oil, War and The Fate of Industrial Societies*.

Michigan Schools Miss NCLB Targets - Forced to Restructure

WASHINGTON - April 23, 2008 - The number of Michigan schools in restructuring under No Child Left Behind (NCLB) rose for the 2007-08 school year, according to a new report from the Washington, D.C.-based Center on Education Policy (CEP). The report attributed restructuring in 2006-07. Geographically, most this rise, in part, to a greater number of high of the 63 schools (84 percent) in restructuring schools failing to meet state targets on a new in 2007-08 were in urban areas, and 68 percent state-mandated high school test.

The study also found that Michigan has refined strategies for assisting schools in restructuring to provide more targeted options, ending what had been a "smorgasbord" of choices. Michigan has been developing strategies for NCLB school restructuring since 2003-04. NCLB requires schools to undergo restructuring after they fail to meet state test-score requirements for five consecutive years.

"Before [restructuring] was like a buffet," said Betty Underwood, interim director of Michigan's Office of School Improvement. "Now we've moved on to a sit-down dinner. You have to have your protein. You have to have your vegetables. And you have to eat your dinner before you have dessert."

The report, The Sit-Down Dinner: Formalizing Restructuring Under the No Child Left Behind Act in Michigan, also finds that more than half the schools in restructuring (34) recently entered the planning phase, with the majority (27) of these being high schools. If not for these high schools, the number of Michigan schools in restructuring would again have declined. The report notes that for the first time, high schools were evaluated based on the performance of 11th-graders on the Michigan Merit Exam, which replaced the Michigan Educational Assessment Plan in 2007.

In the 2007-08 school year, 63 Michigan schools that receive federal Title I support are in the planning or implementation phase of restructuring. That is down from a high of 109 in 2004-05, but well above the 46 schools in were from Detroit, including one charter

The Michigan Department of Education is taking a more prescriptive role in helping schools in restructuring, the report finds. In the 2007-08 school year, the state for the first time offered a set plan of restructuring assistance: leadership coaches who work with principals in their schools, professional-development fellowships for principals, auditors who monitor schools, and Process Mentor Teams that review the improvement process and help set goals.

"Yesterday, Secretary of Education Margaret Spellings called on states and schools to go beyond efforts that have not helped improve our lowest-performing schools. Michigan appears to be moving in this direction with its new strategies to help schools in restructuring," said Jack Jennings, president and CEO of CEP.

Officials at the nine restructuring schools featured in the report said they welcomed the new assistance from the state. They especially appreciated that the assistance was tailored to school needs. Several, however, said the Process Mentor Teams and leadership coaches were slow in starting and hoped that next year the assistance would be available at the very beginning of the school year.

In addition to the new state assistance, schools are still required by federal law to

choose a restructuring strategy. Hiring a turnaround specialist or coach remains the most common option chosen by schools in restructuring in Michigan and is recommended by the Michigan Department of Education to most schools.

The state discourages replacing most of the school staff, and the percentage of schools using this option is relatively low, just 7 percent. The state also discourages the "any other" option available to schools because it is vague and difficult to monitor. In fact, the percentage of schools using this option decreased from 23 percent to 7 percent in 2006-07.

According to the report, which draws on interviews with state and local officials and from an extensive review of state records from September 2007 through February 2008, a combination of multiple strategies continues to be more effective than a single strategy. More than half (57 percent) of schools using three or more options over two years exited restructuring while only 22 percent of schools using two or fewer exited that status.

"Most school and district officials see restructuring as an ongoing process that requires various strategies rather than relying on any one option as the guaranteed fix," Jennings added.

The Center on Education Policy has conducted a series of analyses of the school restructuring efforts in California, Maryland, and Michigan as part of its comprehensive, multiyear study of the No Child Left Behind Act. In 2008, NCLB school restructuring efforts in Ohio and Georgia and will also be studied. The restructuring reports and other CEP publications on NCLB are available at www.cep-dc.org.

Around 102 men are listed and so many more eventually succumbed to other war-related afflictions.
