

Clueless: Censorship Hearing Starts With Democrats Trying to Censor Robert Kennedy By Victoria Taft | July 20, 2023

What if you held a hearing on government censorship but no one could speak because they'd been censored? Humorless and clueless Democrats tried this stunt during a committee meeting on Capitol Hill on Thursday. It would have succeeded had Republicans not let it happen.

The Select Subcommittee on the Weaponization of the Federal Government hearing on government censorship suffered this inauspicious beginning when congressional Democrats and an outside group called for the censorship of one of the witnesses, Robert F. Kennedy, Jr.

My PJ Media colleague Ben Bartee reported that it began when Democrats sent a letter to the Committee demanding that Kennedy be silenced at the hearing on censorship. The letter was penned by a far-Left organization called the Congressional Integrity Project, a group that targets Republicans and is staffed by many former Obama officials and financed by the Leftist foundation Arabella Advisors.

Committee Democrats, led by Vice Chair Stacey Plaskett, a non-voting representative from the U.S. Virgin Islands and representing the party of Rep. Pramila Jayapal (D-Wash.) and the rest of the Jew-hating "squad," accused the Democrat presidential candidate of anti-Semitism. Kennedy was knocked for comments he made about the COVID-19 virus and its effect on Jewish and black people.

"There is an argument that it is ethnically targeted. COVID-19 attacks certain races disproportionately," Kennedy said. "COVID-19 is targeted to attack Caucasians and black people. The people who are most immune are Ashkenazi Jews and Chinese."

"We don't know whether it was deliberately targeted or not but there are papers out there that show the racial or ethnic differential and impact," Kennedy hedged.

There are <u>studies</u> showing how the virus affected ethnicities differently, but Democrats decided this was a racist statement. Kennedy was outraged at the letter and the attempt to censor him even as the hearing began.

The moment he started talking, the Democrats went into censorship mode by making motions to censor Kennedy, points of order, accusations, and finally a vote to table Rep. Debbie Wasserman-Schultz's (D-Fla.) motion to cancel Kennedy's "testimony and degradation" and put it behind closed doors so the poor American people would not be subjected to words spoken by Joe Biden's primary opponent.

Kennedy held up the letter, which claimed he had "repeatedly and recently spread vile and dangerous antisemitic and anti-Asian conspiracy theories that tarnish his credibility as a witness and must not be legitimized," and indignantly said:

In my entire life and why I'm under oath. In my entire life, I have never uttered a phrase that is either racist or antisemitic. I have spent my entire life – fighting in my professional career-fighting for Israel.

[...] I am being censored here through targets, through smears, through misinterpretations of what I've said. through lies through association which is a tactic which we all thought had been discredited and dispensed with after the Army McCarthy hearings in the 1950s. But those same weapons are now being deployed against me, to silence me. I know many of the people who wrote this letter. I don't believe there's a single person who believes who signed this letter who believes I'm anti-semitic. I do not believe that. There is no evidence.


Former Congressman Dennis Kucinich, who is Kennedy's campaign manager, sat behind Kennedy.



The New Authoritarians: How Professors Are Now Calling for Biden to Simply Defy the Supreme Court By Jonathan Turley | July 24, 2023



Below is my column in the Hill on the call of professors for President Joe Biden to simply defy the Supreme Court and decide for himself what is constitutional and what is not.

Here is the column:

"I shall resist any illegal federal court order."

When "the Court's interpretation of the Constitution is egregiously wrong," the president should refuse to follow it.

Those two statements were made roughly 60 years apart. The first is from segregationist Alabama Gov. George Wallace (D). The second was made by two liberal professors this month.

In one of the most chilling developments in our history, the left has come to embrace the authoritarian language and logic of segregationists in calling for defiance and radical measures against the Supreme Court.

In a recent open letter, Harvard law professor Mark Tushnet and San Francisco State University political scientist Aaron Belkin called upon President Joe Biden to defy rulings of the Supreme Court that he considers "mistaken" in the name of "popular constitutionalism." Thus, in light of the court's bar on the use of race in college admissions, they argue that Biden should just continue to follow his own constitutional interpretation.

The use of the affirmative action case is ironic, since polls have consistently shown that the majority of the public does not support the use of race in college admissions. Indeed, even in the most liberal states, such as California, voters have repeatedly rejected affirmative action in college admissions. Polls further show that a majority support the Supreme Court's recent decisions.

So despite referenda and polls showing majority support for barring race in admissions, academics are pushing to impose their own values, regardless of the views of the public or of the courts.

However, even if these measures were popular, it would not make them right. It is precisely what segregationists such as Sen. James Eastland (D-Miss.) <u>argued</u>, that "all the people of the South are in favor of segregation. And Supreme Court or no Supreme Court, we are going to maintain segregated schools."

Tushnet and Belkin cite with approval Biden's declaration that this is "not a normal Supreme Court." Biden's view of normalcy appears to be a court that agrees with his fluid view of constitutional law, by which he can forgive roughly a half of trillion dollars in loans or impose a national eviction moratorium without a vote of Congress.

Tushnet and Belkin know their audience. Biden has previously evinced little respect for the Constitution or the courts. Take the eviction case. In an <u>earlier decision</u>, a majority of justices had declared that Biden's actions were unconstitutional, confirming what many of us had said for months.

Even after the majority declared it unconstitutional, Biden wanted to reissue the national moratorium. White House counsel and most scholars told him the move would be blatantly unconstitutional and defy the express ruling of the court. Instead, he consulted the only law professor willing to tell him what he wanted to hear and did it anyway. It was quickly again declared unconstitutional.

Other commentators and academics have gone from implied to open contempt for our constitutional norms.

Georgetown University Law School Professor Rosa Brooks was celebrated for her appearance on MSNBC's "The ReidOut" after declaring that Americans are "slaves" to the U.S. Constitution and that the Constitution itself is now the problem for the country.

MSNBC commentator Elie Mystal called the U.S. Constitution "trash" and argued that we should simply just dump it.

Rep. Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez (D-N.Y.) has <u>questioned the need for a Supreme Court</u>.

In a New York Times column, "The Constitution Is Broken and Should Not Be Reclaimed," law professors Ryan D. Doerfler of Harvard and Samuel Moyn of Yale called for the Constitution to be "radically altered" to "reclaim America from constitutionalism."

So the danger is now "constitutionalism," as opposed to what Tushnet and Belkin call "popular constitutionalism."

Many have called for the court to be packed with liberal appointees to bring it back to what Biden views as "normal." Some of these calls before Biden's Supreme Court commission echoed the same views as Tushnet and Belkin. Indeed, they cite Harvard professor Nikolas Bowie, who rejected the notion that "the constitutional interpretation held by a majority of Supreme Court justices should be 'superior' to the interpretations held by majorities of the other branches."

The Framers saw the Supreme Court as playing a counter-majoritarian role when it is necessary to protect individual rights and constitutional norms. The alternative is what the Framers viewed as a tyranny of the majority, where popularity rather than principle prevails. For that reason, the Court has often stood with the least popular in our society and, since <u>Marbury v. Madison</u>, has had the final word on what the Constitution means.

Justice Robert Jackson once observed that he and his colleagues "are not final because we are infallible, we are infallible because we are final."

That finality has been essential to the stability of our system for generations. While presidents such as Andrew Jackson taunted the court for its inability to enforce its rulings without an army, it has never needed one. Respect for the court is in our DNA. No matter our disagreements with a given decision, Americans will not tolerate defiance of the institution and the rule of law. That is why, despite the support for court packing by many law professors (including Tushnet, Belkin and Bowie), the public remains staunchly opposed to it.

What is most striking about these professors is how they continue to claim they are defenders of democracy, yet seek to use unilateral executive authority to defy the courts and, in cases like the tuition forgiveness and affirmative action, the majority of the public. They remain the privileged elite of academia, declaring their values as transcending both constitutional and democratic processes.

The problem is indeed "constitutionalism," and their view of "popular constitutionalism" is a euphemism for "popular justice."

Tushnet and Belkin show the release that comes with rejecting constitutionalism. They declare that it is not enough merely to pack the court: "The threat that MAGA justices pose is so extreme that reforms that do not require congressional approval are needed at this time, and advocates and experts should encourage President Biden to take immediate action to limit the damage."

In other words, they are calling for Biden to declare himself the final arbiter of what the Constitution means and to exercise unilateral executive power without congressional approval. He is to become a government unto himself.

No doubt a new variation of "popular constitutionalism" would then be crafted if a Republican were ever elected and proceeded to mete out an alternative view of justice.

This is what Tushnet has advocated in "taking the Constitution away from the courts." Once the courts are removed from constitutionalism, however, we will be left where we began centuries ago: with the fleeting satisfaction of popular justice.

Biden admin confirms it's withholding key funds for schools with hunting courses, GOP call it 'shameful' Biden administration says it is interpreting recently-passed law 'as written by Congress' to block funding

The Biden administration confirmed to Fox News Digital that it is withholding critical funds for elementary and secondary schools nationwide with hunting or archery programs in their curriculum.

The Department of Education explained in a statement that its funding decisions were based on the plain text interpretation of the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act (BSCA), which Congress passed and President Biden signed last year after a string of mass shootings. The agency's interpretation means funding for shooting sport activities earmarked under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) of 1965 will be blocked across the country.

"This prohibition applies to all ESEA funds," a Department of Education spokesperson told Fox News Digital. "The prohibition went into effect immediately on June 25, 2022 and applies to all existing and future awards under all ESEA programs, including [21st Century Community Learning Centers]. The Department is administering the bipartisan law as written by Congress."

Overall, the administration's decision to withhold funds for such programs may impact thousands of schools and millions of American students.

Fox News Digital reported last week that federal guidance highlighting the Education Department's funding decision and interpretation of the BSCA was circulated among hunting education groups earlier this year, sparking concerns about the future of hunting and archery programs in schools.

Tommy Floyd, the president of the National Archery in the Schools Program, told Fox News Digital his organization boasts 1.3 million students from nearly 9,000 schools across 49 states who are enrolled in archery courses. Some of those schools have already canceled plans to include archery or hunting education courses in their curriculum due to the federal guidance.

"It's a negative for children. As a former educator of 30-plus years, I was always trying to find a way to engage students," Floyd said in an interview last week. "In many communities, it's a shooting sport, and the skills from shooting sports, that help young people grow to be responsible adults. They also benefit from relationships with role models."

According to the International Hunter Education Association, hunter education courses train and certify more than 500,000 students annually. Such courses are a reason hunting related injury rates have declined for years while populations of deer, wild turkey, elk, geese and other species of game have increased exponentially for

In June 2022, the BSCA was passed with large majorities in the House and Senate before Biden signed it into law. The push to pass the bill — which broadly seeks to promote "safer, more inclusive and positive" school environments, according to the Education Department - came after mass shootings at a grocery market in Buffalo, New York, and a school in Uvalde, Texas.

The legislation included an amendment to an ESEA subsection listing prohibited uses for federal school funding. That amendment prohibits ESEA funds from helping provide any person with a dangerous weapon or to provide "training in the use of a dangerous

However, in a letter to Education Secretary Miguel Cardona earlier this month, Sens. John Cornyn, R-Texas, and Thom Tillis, R-N.C., expressed concern that the agency is misinterpreting the provision which they said was included in the BSCA last year to withhold education funds for programs training school resource officers, not to preclude funding for hunting and archery classes. School resource officer training was funded under a separate provision.

In addition, other GOP lawmakers have since blasted the Biden administration over its interpretation of the BSCA

"Hunting has been a tradition since the be-

ginning of human history. The Biden admin's decision to push its elitist values on Tennesseans isn't going to fly," Rep. Mark Green, R-Tenn., who chairs the Homeland Security Committee, said in response to the Fox News Digital report last week. "This is shameful, but not at all surprising," Rep. Dan Bishop. R-N.C., added. "The Biden admin will take any opportunity to stomp on your constitutional rights — even down to teaching kids archery and hunting skills."

The ESEA is the primary source of federal aid for elementary and secondary education across the country, according to the Congressional Research Service. The BSCA earmarked an additional \$1 billion for educational activities under the ESEA.

"The Biden administration is DEFUND-ING school hunting and archery programs. Yes, you read that right - DE-FUNDING them," Rep. Tom Tiffany, R-Wisc., tweeted Friday. "Wisconsin students should not be pawns in Joe Biden's misguided crusade against America's sportsmen."

"Enjoying the outdoors is a wonderful activity and interest in hunting, fishing, camping, and other such activities should be encouraged and cultivated from a young age," Rep. Doug LaMalfa, R-Calif., said. "Withholding authorized funding is ridiculous."

Hunting and pro-Second Amendment groups like Safari Club International, National Shooting Sports Foundation, International Order of T. Roosevelt and National Rifle Association also criticized the Education Department.

"This is a direct attack on our outdoor heritage and America's ability to educate the next generation of sportsmen," the International Order of T. Roosevelt tweeted.

CDC Discovers COVID-19 Among Other Diseases In Illegal Medical Lab

An illegal medical laboratory that was filled with bioengineered mice containing viruses such as COVID-19, HIV and Malaria has been discovered in Fresno, California.

Following months of investigation, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and federal authorities have found hundreds of mice containing infectious diseases in a warehouse.

There had also been reports that medical waste and hazardous materials were discovered.

On Thursday, Joe Prado, the Fresno County Public Health Department assistant director, released a statement regarding the situation.

"The Fresno County Public Health De- were detected with at least 20 potential inpartment has been evaluating and assessing the activities of an unlicensed laboratory," he said. "The evaluation required coordination and collaboration with multiple federal and state agencies to determine and classify biological and chemical contents onsite, in addition to assessing jurisdictional authority under this unique situation."

On March $3^{\rm rd}$, court documents stated that city investigators began searching the unlicensed lab company, known as Prestige BioTech, due to building violations. After a second search completed on March 16th, public health officials uncovered a room where they suspected the production of pregnancy tests as well as COVID-19

According to the documents, more than 800 biological chemicals such as blood, tissue and other bodily fluids were found. Additionally, nearly 1,000 lab mice were discovered on site and fectious diseases including HIV, Hepatitis and Malaria.


The press reported that Wang Zhaolin, a representative of Prestige BioTech, claimed that the mice found had been "genetically engineered to catch and spread the COVID-19 virus."

Reportedly, the rodents were taken by authorities in April. Out of all the mice found, roughly 800 had been euthanized and 175 were found already dead.

As stated by court documents, Prestige Bio-Tech failed to provide a license that allows any laboratory activity.

In July, Prado announced that all dangerous materials had been eliminated. An inquiry into the origins of the illicit medical lab and all lab operations is still ongoing.

Mystery Outbreak of a Deadly, Paralyzing Disease Has Experts Baffled


A national state of emergency has been declared in Peru as doctors battle an outbreak of a rare disease that can cause lifelong paralysis or death.

More than 230 cases of Guillain-Barré syndrome have been reported in the South American country, with more than half the cases occurring in a brief fiveweek period from June to July.

Normally a rare disorder, GBS typically strikes only about 3,000 people per year in the US, according to Johns Hopkins Medicine.

Four people in Peru have reportedly died of the disease since the beginning of the year, and the still-unknown cause of the outbreak has health officials scrambling.

"I think the origins of this [outbreak] remain still not completely investigated," Dr. William Schaffner, an infectious disease specialist at Vanderbilt University Medical Center in Nashville, Tennessee, told Healthline.



What an Amazing Gift!

Rambling, from a Yooper farmer's perspective by James Niemela

What a beautifully busy time it's been on the farm! We're doing market 3 days a week, and soon will be opening up our farm stand near home, probably one day a week anyway.

We've been kept busy, with all kinds of garden work. Pruning and tying up tomatoes, cultivating, hilling spuds, planting more succession crops; in the last few days or so we've seeded in hundreds of kale in soil blocks, and more lettuce. The lettuce will mature for our late fall sales, and the kale will be ready for our winter sales.

For anyone wondering about the pruning tomatoes part, there are two different types of tomato plants....three really. Determinate, semi-determinate, and indeterminate. The determinate kind are bush tomatoes, they generally shouldn't be pruned. The semi-determinate type ramble a bit more, so can be pruned lightly if at all.

The indeterminate type are kind of like yours truly- they will ramble on and on, all over, unless kept in check. I try to keep myself in check, but it's hard sometimes. When my brain works, my mouth keeps going, or my fingers keep pecking away. It does, however, provide me an easy excuse, if something goes overly long, and folks wonder what took me so long-"They wouldn't stop listening to me!!":)

Anyway, the indeterminate vines will grow longer and longer, and set many rambling sideshoots; so we try to keep a balance between fruit and vine. On the cherry type, I like to take the sideshoots off, up to the one just below the first blossom cluster, then let two vines develop, and continue taking side shoots off those two vines (and also try to keep up on tying them up to the support stakes as needed).

Often when they get quite tall, we get too busy to keep up on the pruning as much, but by that time the plant is well established so I'm not so concerned with pushing it; and of course, the season is getting later, with the inevitable cool weather, so at some point it becomes a case of diminishing returns. The key is airflow-thick foliage close to the ground, keeping things damp and hindering airflow, is a recipe for foliar diseases like Septoria Leaf Spot or blights.

It seems we always get some leaf diseases anyway, and no wonder. We're asking a tropical perennial plant to grow in a cool, short season like ours. It's a wonder we get any tomatoes. Since they were originally tropical perennials, they think it's summer forever; we know it's not long before winter comes knocking at the door, so we try to hasten the harvest.

By removing some of the foliage, the plant can direct more energy to the fruitmaking process. We've already eaten a few of the little Sungold tomatoes this season, and soon they should start appearing on our tables at market. The squash are vining out nicely now, with baby squash appearing- Amish Pie Squash, Acorn, Delicata, New England Pie Pumpkin, Long Island Cheese Pumpkin, North Georgia Candy Roaster squash, Butternut, and I think there's some spaghetti squash out there as well.

This morning I did some hand pollinating of New England Pie Pumpkin and Amish Pie squash; saving seed from them will ensure there's seed for next year, come what may abroad or at home. It also will help the plants get acclimated to our soil, microclimate, and management practices.

We generally save seed from a number of different types of plants each year, for seed to replant in coming seasons.

Over the years, we've learned how to save seed from lettuce, beets, carrots, tomatoes, peppers, peas, beans, squash, watermelons, bunching onions, kale, a couple herbs like dill and cilantro, radish, and probably some others I'm not recalling at the moment. Seeds are the spark of the farm.....no seed, no food. So, I like to back myself up with the knowhow of seed saving; while I do buy seed every year, if push came to shove, I wouldn't HAVE TO buy seed.

Hand pollinating the squash in a way so the bees don't cause crosses, is quite an easy process. You go out the evening before, and select the male and female blossoms you want to pollinate. Poke a stick or sturdy plant stem into the ground near them, so you can find them again. You generally want to select

blossoms from different plants, and it helps if you use a bigger number of males to females to keep the genetic diversity varied, to prevent inbreeding collapse.


The female blossoms are easy to identifythey have a tiny pumpkin, zucchini, or whatever you're growing, at the base of the flower. You can tell which flowers are ready, and would open the next morning (if you didn't tape them shut), by the slight orange streaking on them.

You take a bit of tape and tape the end of the blossoms shut, so they don't open before you get there, and have some bee bring pollen from a different squash into the flower. In the morning, simply pick the male blossoms, bring them to the females, then gently tear off the end of the blossoms, tearing off the petals from the male until only the stamen is left, then roll it around and over the pistil of the female flower, to transfer some pollen. Then gently tape the female flower shut again, to prevent bees from going in and messing up your breeding process by bringing in other pollen. It sounds complicated, but actually it's easy as apple pie.

It's really amazing the diversity of plants God created. Some are naturally self-pollinating (tomatoes, lettuce, beans, peas, and some others), and don't need the action of bees. Others (corn, brassicas, squashes, beets, carrots, and many more) need cross-pollinating, or they won't set fruit. Some plants have both male and female flowers, others have either male or female flowers, but not both on the same plant.

To think that God simply spoke it all into existence, is amazing. What a mighty God! And the most amazing thing of all, is that He condescends to men of low estate, sent His Son to die for us, to save us from our sins!

Mankind who was created perfect in the image of God, but fell through disobedience in the Garden of Eden, and we as descendants of Adam and Eve, who inherited a fallen nature from our forefathers, can be reborn through repentance and faith in Jesus, and become the sons and daughters of the Most High God! What an amazing gift!



Grilled Chicken Caprese

INGREDIENTS

1 tbsp. red wine vinegar3 tbsp. plus 2 tsp. olive oil

kosher salt black pepper 1 small shallot, finely chopped

1 c. corn kernels (from 1 large ear, or frozen and thawed)

1 pt. mixed-color grape or cherry tomatoes, halved

4 6-oz. boneless, skinless, chicken breasts

DIRECTIONS

Step 1: Heat grill to medium-high. Clean the grill and lightly oil. In a medium bowl, whisk together the vinegar, 3 tablespoon oil and 1/2 teaspoon each salt and pepper; stir in the shallot. Add the corn and grape tomatoes and toss to combine; set aside.

Step 2: Rub the chicken with the remaining 2 teaspoon olive oil, season with 1/2 teaspoon salt and 1/4 teaspoon pepper, and grill until just cooked through, 4 to 6 minutes per side.
